LOGLINE & SYNOPSIS

Locket is a short film that follows the unravelling journey of young girl who is unknowingly living in an alternate life.

As fragments of Maya's broken reality starts to seep through, it leads Maya to chase after the truth and discover appreciation in her old life. The film deliberately portrays diversity in hopes to normalise diverse love within cultural families as well as focusing on the concept of appreciation, questioning what people would lose if they traded their life for another.

ABOUT

Locket is an inspired story that focuses on what could have been if certain situations in life never happened. It challenges everyday life within contemporary society that people face which leads to the ultimate question: Would you trade your life for another... but at what cost. Maya experiences vivid flashbacks of her life, including her father attempting to hit her mother, remembering her boyfriend Lucas and seeing her sister asking Maya to never leave again. Maya runs to seek the truth.

There is no doubt that people have experienced broken homes, divorce and loss or faced the idea of diverse love being typically frowned upon within modern society. these issues may become the roots of Mental Health. The film follows the theme of finding appreciation in life, offering hope and conveying across strength into leading your own life.

SCRIPT

ROLES & RESPONSABILITIES

I was scriptwriter, producer and director. I mainly contributed to the entire pre-production roles, casting actors, finding crew, exploring locations, creating shot lists and sorting out schedules as well as doing all the documentation necessary in order to start filming. Throughout post production I participated in assisting with editing, Foley and sound. I over saw the whole process and provided constant feedback with the editors and cinematographer. I researched inspirations and themes and carefully picked my actors in order to ensure that I create the impact and meaning I wanted to convey across within the film. My role also consisted of creating the music for the film. The CGI of the eyes was created by myself as I wanted to avoid any complications with the actor putting eye contacts in, pushing myself beyond the limit and aiming to develop new skills.

As a director, I wanted create the film as if the audience is carried through the journey with the main protagonist, going through the emotions of confliction and confusion, loneliness and the ideology of not fitting in. The process began in researching different directors, the style and how they use their creative vision to create the story they want. David Fincher's directing style inspired me. "it takes titanium and aluminium and steel and glass to do one thing, impart feeling to everyone in the audience at the same exact same time, and that's the magic of cinema". This quote explains how we make our films so memorable where I should allow the audience to feel the film rather than just to see it. When directing, the process was not just one take, it was rehearsed before shooting and then took another take on top where the scene was repeated until it was perfected, directing the cast to use different emotions so that through post-production we are able to keep the emotions and theme of each scene with consistent tone that would piece the film together. One of Fincher's styles is to use deception where it makes it difficult to navigate what is happening within the storyline, just like the protagonist in her own story differentiating between her realities.



However, it's not just about mental health, it's the **influence**, the **cause** or the **crime** that leads to the downfall of a person's **mind**. This is what I also **focus** on. On top of writing a story or a **song**, I write a **life**... the one of my best friend who introduced her **skin** to a **knife**, or the brother who **died** and the family that **cried** with **pain** in their **eyes**.

This is my **manifesto**, beginning with the story of my **life**.



ROLES & RESPONSABILITIES

My main role in this project was Director which over seen the project. As it was the first time taking a role as a director, I got to experience what it is like to have a responsibility that manages the whole project. I found this both exciting but also quite stressful as I had to ensure everyone and everything was planned and organised. As a result, I had created a calendar timetable so that everyone knew when and what is happening on that day. We also set up frequent meetings to catch each other up on what we have done.

My role also consited in me creating the schedule, redoing the audio, some of the cinemtography, writing the transcript and sitting with the editor to help him edit.

The music was covered by me, originally written by Ludovico Einaudi called 'Life'. I remade the song, changing the tempo and pitch so that it would suit the documentary better. I played the whole piece on piano, and added a synth string to make sure it didn't sound too boring and simple.




